**SALEM'S ONLY PRIVATE DENTAL ASSISTING SCHOOL TO OFFER
RADIOLOGIC PROFICIENCY COURSE**

JANUARY 23, 2008 (SALEM, OR) – Willamette Valley Dental Assisting School, LLC (WVDAS) announces the formation of its new Radiologic Proficiency Course.

This course is for practicing dental assistants without a state-issued radiology certificate or for those wishing to complete requirements for Expanded Function requirements via the Dental Assisting National Board (DANB). It is also a highly recommended course for WVDAS graduates.
