**SALEM'S ONLY PRIVATE DENTAL ASSISTING SCHOOL
TO OFFER SEALANT COURSE**

FEBRUARY 18, 2008 (SALEM, OR) – Willamette Valley Dental Assisting School, LLC (WVDAS) announces a new course offering for ALL Existing Dental Assistants: A complete course in Sealants, Pits & Fissures.

This course is for practicing dental assistants *lacking* a state-issued sealant certificate or for those wishing to complete requirements for Expanded Function requirements via the Dental Assisting National Board (DANB). It is also a highly recommended course for WVDAS graduates.

The first class is scheduled to start this April and will be taught on Fridays throughout 2008.
